JUST SHARING ... A FEW CORE CIRCLE OF ALL NATIONS PRINCIPALS FROM LEARNING FROM A KINDERGARTEN DROPOUT (2005)

- A spiritual (not to be confused with religious) foundation is integral to the way of life
- The medicine wheel serves as our conceptual tool to access complexity
- Ginawaydaganuc relationship operates at multiple complex levels
- The huge distinction between *individuality* (the individual is a unique part of the biodiverse eco-community) and *individualism* (the rights of one supersede the rights of the community as free will) is understood
- The individual and community are inextricably interconnected
- Conflict is negotiated with responsibility, respect, generosity and compassion to access harmony and balance we call it "Being Good Enough for Two!"

- Renowned birch bark canoe maker and craftsman
- Political Algonquin leader, elder, chief, supreme chief the North American Indigenous Nations Government
- Founder of the Circle of All Nations, a global eco-peace-community dedicated to advancing environmental stewardship and racial harmony
- Officer of the Order of Canada and recipient of two honorary doctorate degrees; spokesperson at the UN
- University of Ottawa Chancellor Michaelle Jean (GG) created Commanda Hall in recognition of his relevance to academic knowledge in 2014



INDIGENOUS ROOTS OF CIVIL ACTIVISM

- Earlier (Pontiac, Tecumseh, etc) then 1920s and 1945 and the Indigenous Roots of Civil Rights Activism in North America Jules Sioui, John Chabot, William Commanda and NAING
- To understand William Commada's own thinking about Indigenous activism and rights, check out his own words on pages 144 149 of our thesis (see last page for ref)
- Did you know that JULES SIOUI was imprisoned for challenging oppression of Indigenous Peoples in North America at the UN Level?
- Did you know he went on a longer hunger strike than Mahatha Gandhi?
- Did you know that William Commanda intervened to get him out of prison?
- Did you know the case of treason against him had been dismissed but that they kept him imprisoned for months while he starved?
- Interesting that William Commanda died on Jules Sioui's birthday

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE NORTH AMERICAN INDIAN NATION

- Dedicated to the Memory of Jules Sioui and William Commanda
- Friend, Mentor, Colleague of William Commanda, Supreme Chief of the North American Indian Nation Government, a title he held till his death
- 1945 and the INDIGENOUS roots of civil rights activism in North America which inspired the later antioppression movement that are sadly still a part of our reality
- This was the percursor to the Native Indian Brotherhood, now Assembly of First Nations; also to Black Civil Rights movement in States and beyond




