His Algonquin name is Ojigkwanong and it means Morning Star. Born on the eve of the first World War on 11 November 1913, today, a hundred and seven years later, he is seen by many as a beacon of light in an ever darkening world.

Twenty twenty marks the anniversary of two important pivotal events in the long history of his work and outreach – the 25th year since the launch of The Sunbow Five Walk of 1995/96 and the 20th anniversary of the Circle of All Nations International Millennium Peace Gathering.

MILLENNIUM PEACE GATHERING

At this precise moment, we are celebrating the 20th Anniversary of the Circle of All Nations International Millennium Peace Gathering hosted at Nepean Point, Ottawa, Canada from May 22 to the 25. Nepean Point, he told me means "The place where we sleep"; thus he affirmed that Ottawa was the gathering place of his ancestors from time immemorial.

He organized his first international gathering in Eganville Ontario in 1967, affirming Indigenous welcome on the occasion of Canada's 100th birthday.

He hosted the first gathering of the First Peoples of North America in 1969, affirming connection across Turtle Island.

He said "We must come together with one heart, one mind, one love and one determination, to create a Circle of All Nations, A Culture of Peace"



SUNBOW FIVE WALK FOR MOTHER EARTH

He served as the Spiritual Guide for the Sunbow Five Walk for Mother Earth, from June 23 1995 to February 3, 1996. He gathered up walkers along the long trail from First Encounter Beach in Massachusetts to Santa Barbara, California, the site of the harshest mission in North America, taking Indigenous prayer and ceremony to land besmirched by bloodshed, inspiring healing and reconciliation.



DONALD MARSHALL JUNIOR

During the Millennium Conference, The Wolf Project presented an Award to Donald Marshall Junior, whose historical name is now synonymous with the struggle for Indigenous Justice in the Criminal Justice System, with the Wrongfully Convicted, Indigenous Rights to land and resources, and youth empowerment. Despite the systemic and overt oppression he had suffered from youth, he, like Grandfather Commanda, built bridges with diverse peoples, and was a key advocate for the Asinabka Indigenous Centre at the Sacred Chaudiere Site.



Indeed the Millennium Gathering drew attention to racial harmony and peace building. Garnet Challenger organized a concert that had Indigenous Prophecy Carriers like Martin Gashwaseoma, Hopi, and Arvol Looking Horse, Lakota, and others like Frank Decontie, Algonquin and

Angaangar Lybert, Inuit, tapping their feet to the Reggae beat, and created his song "One Race, Many Colours" for the gathering. Wayquay sang "Grandfather Sent me on a Walk to make Medicine out of Pain", and quite literally called in the Thunder.

The newly appointed Governor General Adrienne Clarkson joined us for a special circle meeting, and did you know the Northern Cree Singers drummed and danced for us

We had representatives from The Rosa Parks Foundation, the 4 H Program, Peace and Reconciliation Australia, National Association of Child and Youth Care Workers and Umtapo Peace Education, South Africa, Wittenberg Centre, A Healing Among Nations, International Institute for Restorative Practices, Four Worlds International, and many special Indigenous leaders like Douglas Cardinal and Freda Ens.



DR WILLIAM COMMANDA, OC

Over the years, more and more folk began to understand the power and wisdom of this special Indigenous elder. We wrote a book about him and called it LEARNINGFROM A KINDERGARTEN DROPOUT; later he was presented with two honorary doctorate degrees; he received a LIFETIME AWARD FROM THE NATIONAL ABORIGINAL ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS and was appointed OFFICER OF THE ORDER OF CANADA, a penultimate honour for those who "desired a better country".
