




The Handsculpted Map of Africa



The map is 18 metres from north to south. The raised profile is handsculpted in reinforced concrete and stained with metal powders to achieve the aged oxidized colours and textures that indicate the vegetation and topographic features.







Two geometrically formal splayed stone walls to the south and a series of skewed stonewalls follow the angle of the natural The Agulhas Icon Design Group stone topography, to the north. These walls will in time merge with the landscape as vegetation takes hold and the weathering processes make its mark.



A path leads from the circle through a needle-like element (the needle of the compass) towards the existing beacon.

The artists and designers (AIDG): architect Stephen Dugmore, Landscape architects Bernie Oberholzer and Megan Anderson, and land artists Strijdom van der Merwe and Simon Max Bannister.






Stained with metal powders to achieve aged oxidization and texture
